The Beach Boys at The Ryman

Join us for a great concert with **The Beach Boys** at the Ryman in Nashville. Today we board our coach for the short drive to Nashville for a great concert at The Ryman Auditorium. The Ryman, the Mother Church Of Country Music and the home of the Grand Ole Opry from 1943 to 1974, is sacred to the history of country music. We will arrive in Nashville at about 5:30 pm. You will have plenty of time to eat and browse the shops and restaurants of Broadway before the concert begins at 7:30 pm. Take a stroll thru the Earnest Tubb Record store or Tootsie's Orchid Lounge. There is a lot of history here. You can capsulize most pop music acts by reciting how many hits they've had and how many millions of albums they've sold. But these conventional measurements fall short when you're assessing the impact of The Beach Boys. To be sure, this band has birthed a torrent of hit singles and sold albums by the tens of millions. But its greater significance lies in the fact that it changed the musical landscape so profoundly that every pop act since has been in its debt. Happily for us all, The Beach Boys continue to create and perform with the same bold imagination and style that marked their explosive debut over 50 years ago. The Beach Boys are led by Mike Love and Bruce Johnston, who along with Jeffery Foskett, Randell Kirsch, Tim Bonhomme, John Cowsill and Scott Totten continue the legacy of the iconic American band. This tour will not feature Brian Wilson, Al Jardine or David Marks. Love's role as the band's front man sometimes overshadows his stature as one of rock's foremost songwriters. "Surfin'," The Beach Boys' first hit came from his pen. With his cousin, Brian Wilson, Love wrote the classics "Fun, Fun, Fun," "I Get Around," "Help Me Rhonda," "California Girls" and the Grammy nominated "Good Vibrations." Years later, he showed he still had the lyrical chops by co-writing the irresistible and chart-topping "Kokomo." n addition to founding Beach Boy Mike Love (Price includes: transportation by modern motorcoach with air conditioning, bathroom and on board video monitors, Tickets to The Beach Boys concert.
