**Day 1** - Today we are off to Savannah, Georgia. We travel through Atlanta, the capital of Georgia, continuing through Macon, crossing the beautiful farm lands to the great coast. We will arrive at our hotel in historic district of Savannah by late afternoon. After checking into our hotel in the Historic District and a short rest we will enjoy a two-hour dinner cruise down the Savannah River on The Georgia Queen. Menu selections include: Our Signature Savannah Shrimp and Grits, tender Beef Carving Station, Fresh Catch of the Day, Lemon & Artichoke Chicken with Spinach, Roasted Potatoes, Squash Casserole, Seasonal Fresh Vegetables, Southern Side Salads, Fresh Garden Greens with Dressings and Toppings, Seasonal Fruits and much more! After dinner, snap your fingers and tap your feet or get up and dance to tunes from the 50's through today's hits performed by one of our own riverboat entertainers. Venture up to our top deck and enjoy the calm Savannah evenings and the amazing sights and sounds of the historic city of Savannah.



**Day 2** - Our day begins with a good continental breakfast. We meet our guide for a day of touring and FUN in Savannah. Our guide will have a lot of history to share as we tour Savannah. We will visit the Cathedral of Saint John the Baptist a French Gothic-style cathedral founded by the first French colonists in Savannah. Other highlights of the tour include Forsyth Park, Colonial Park Cemetery, River Street, City market, the Waving Girl Statue and one of the historic homes. In the afternoon you will have some time on your own for shopping in the historic district shops or a short rest at our hotel. Next comes a great dinner at Paula Deen's The Lady & Sons Restaurant. The Lady & Sons restaurant had its humble begin-



nings back in June 1989 when Paula Deen started The Bag Lady out of her home. The Bag Lady began as a lunch delivery service with Paula's sons, Jamie and Bobby, delivering bag lunches to area business people in their offices around town. The Bag Lady expanded in 1991 into a full service restaurant named The Lady in the Best Western hotel on Savannah's Southside. After nearly eight months of renovations and overdrawn bank accounts, The new Lady & Sons opened its doors in its present downtown location on January 8, 1996. Next we are off to the historic Savannah Theater for a great musical production. Savannah Live is a high-energy 2 hour variety show that features everything from "Pop" to "Broadway" and "Motown to "Rock & Roll!" The Savannah Theater opened on December 4, 1818 and is the oldest continually operated theater in the country. The theater has undergone several facelifts since it opened. As the result of a fire in 1948 it was restored in the classic 1940's Art Deco style. After the show we will go back to our hotel.

**Day 3**—Today we are off to Visit Jekyll Island . Jekyll Island was host to the world's wealthiest from the 1880's to after World War II when the State of Georgia purchased the island to protect the historical and natural beauty of the island. Here we will board a tram for a 90 minute tour of the island and learn about the history of the island. In Georgia you can really only drive to 3 islands and Jekyll is one of the most visited island in Georgia. The island boasts the only Sea Turtle Hospital in the Southeast. The restored Jekyll Island Club Hotel is a southern landmark of history and where the Federal Reserve was founded and still meets! The island was host to the homes of JP Morgan, Rockefeller, Crane, Pulitzer and many others. We will also have lunch at The Jekyll Island Club where the wealthiest of visitors dined over 100 years ago. We will return to our hotel by about 7:00 PM and you will have dinner on your own around the hotel.



**Day 4** - Today we join our guide for a low country tour. We'll look at salt marsh and rivers and antebellum houses on The Bluff at Isle of Hope. We will stop at the lighthouse at Tybee Island where you can climb the lighthouse and go for a walk on the beach. Next we will climb aboard Capt. Mike's Dolphin Tours and watch the bottle-nosed dolphin playing in their natural habitat. These fun loving, mammals are the most intelligent of creatures next to man and are unusually friendly. They frequently come right up to the boat. The tour departs from Lazaretto Creek Marina, heading toward the Atlantic ocean, passing by shrimp boats and boat docks that portray the charm of an old fishing village. The boat passes by the Cockspur lighthouse (built in 1856), offering a view of historic Fort Pulaski. After our Dolphin Tour we will have lunch return to the hotel. You will have the rest of the evening on your own. We will offer advice on things you might want to do.



**Day 5** - Sleep in, have a nice breakfast and board the bus at 8:00 AM to head home with great memories of this unique southern city. We should arrive home by about 5:30 PM.
